

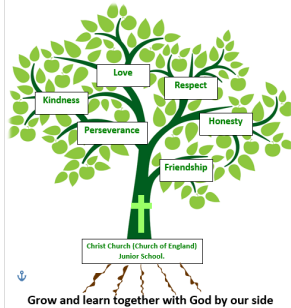

New Dismissal System.

We have had some concerns raised about the end of day procedure via the lower school gate. It can get very congested causing people to walk on the grass which can become slippery. In order to overcome this issue, **there will be a change to dismissal of lower school children from Tuesday 2nd May**

During COVID we used the double gates which give access directly to the playground. From Tuesday 2nd May, this gate will be used for the dismissal of lower school children. Parents will come through this double gate and wait on the playground for their children. The children will come out of their classrooms and be dismissed from the front of the playground. We therefore ask that parents congregate at the back of the playground by the big tree where the children currently line up. Families can then exit through the same double gate. Mornings will stay the same as they are currently.



Both sets of double gates will be opened for parents at 3.15pm. Please do not allow your children to ride bikes and scooters around staff cars. We appreciate your cooperation.

Children will then be dismissed to you from their classroom entrances.



Due to these changes, staff who need to leave the carpark during dismissal time will now be using the double gates which are in front of the school. Please do not park in the keep clear area unless you are a blue badge holder. Blue badge holders may park in this area but please allow enough space for the gates to be opened by exiting staff.

Weekly Safeguarding Tip

Keeping Our Children Safe Online Children need to be aware that they could be committing criminal offences if they post or share anything online that is hateful, harmful, threatening, misogynistic, or grossly offensive. This includes messages, images and voice notes using mobile phones or other electronic devices such as PCs, laptops, tablets, and online gaming chat functions. They may also commit criminal offences if they conduct themselves in such a manner face-to-face. It is important that parents and carers understand that they too have a responsibility to communicate with those in their care about keeping safe online and engaging positively with social media. Regularly talking to children about safe and appropriate online engagement, and encouraging children to discuss anything concerning they may see, is key to keeping children safe. Children and young people should be encouraged to speak up, and let a trusted adult know if they encounter content online or social media that they feel is inappropriate, or 'just doesn't feel right'.
