

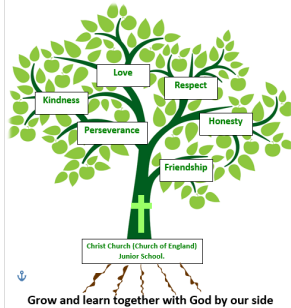

In addition, to help mark the King's Coronation, children will be given the opportunity to take part in a whole school Coronation art competition. Children are invited to create their own interpretation of a portrait of the King. They may use any media of their choice, such as pastels, collage or paints and are encouraged to include the many techniques and styles we have learnt in school. A frame has been provided to create their masterpiece. A winner will be chosen from each year group and presented with a prize in one of our achievement assemblies. A bunting template has also been provided for them to complete as they wish. Please could you ensure the bunting is pre-cut before sending into school. Completed bunting will be displayed as part of our Coronation celebrations. Please ensure both of these are returned to school no later than Tuesday 2nd May 2023. On Thursday 4th May 2023, we will be holding an art exhibition in the hall, at 3.30pm, where the children's artwork will be on display to view. 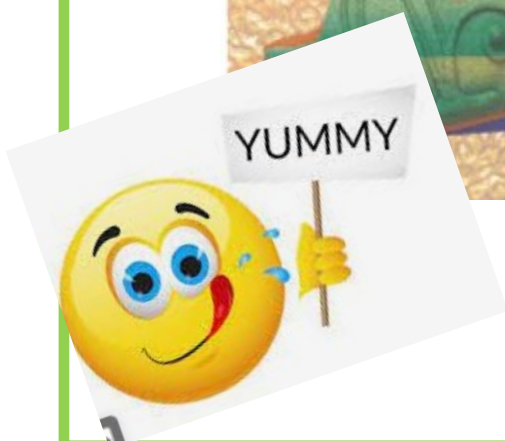
Eid

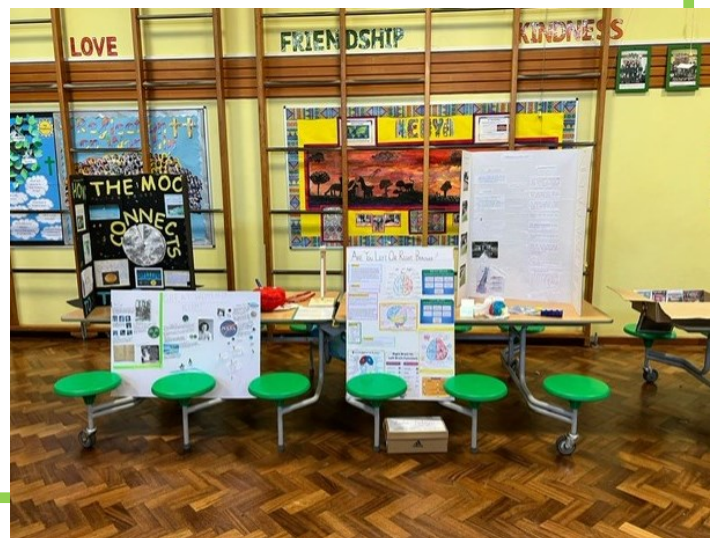
Weekly Safeguarding Tip
