With this in mind, please monitor your child's internet usage carefully.

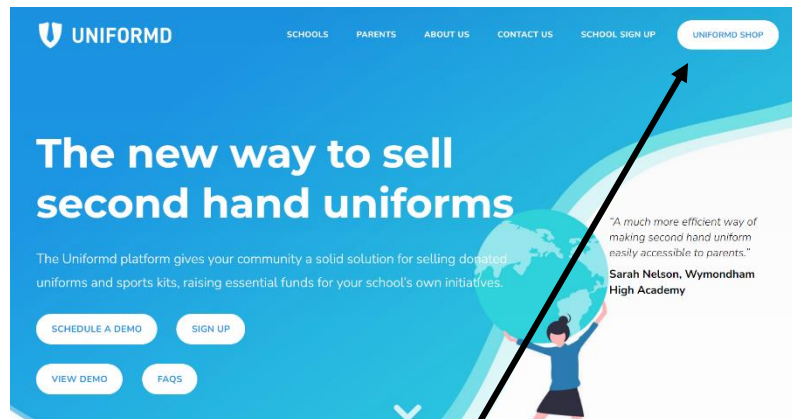
Christ Church Uniform Shop

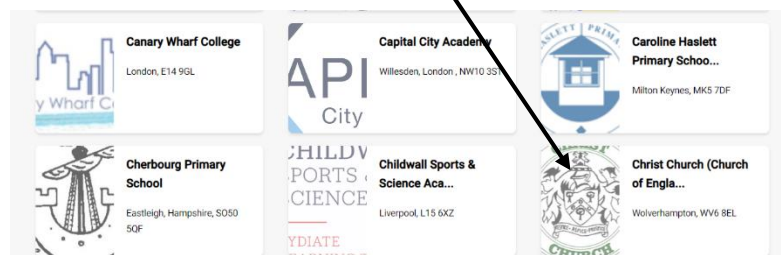
