

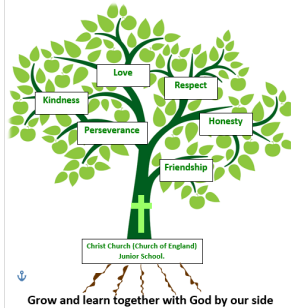

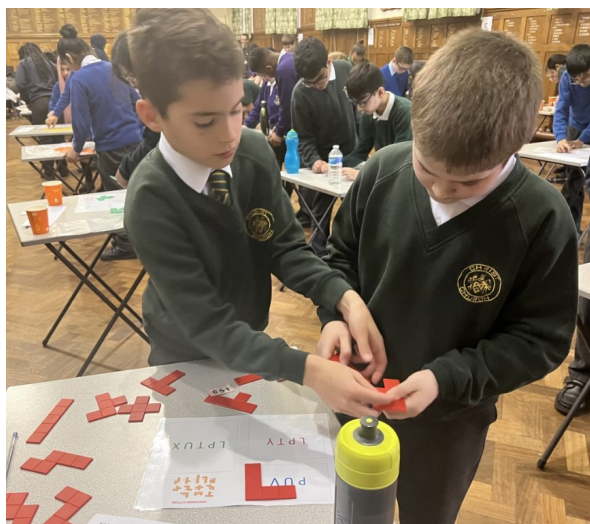
International School Award
