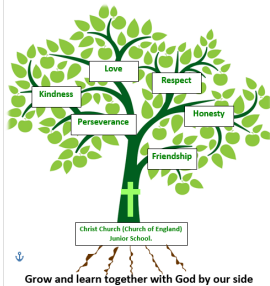

Prayer Space Focus- Pupil contributions

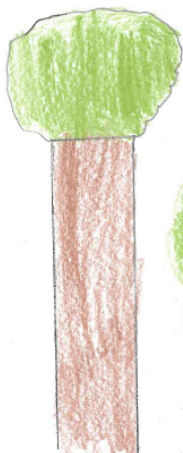
