Notice from Severn Trent

We're improving your supply of wonderful water...

The water pipes in the area have served your community well for many years but recently they've been showing their age, resulting in a number of bursts. When this happens, we have to carry out emergency repairs and your water supplies might be affected. To ensure supplies are secure for the future we're going to replace them with some new ones.

When and where is the work taking place?

The work will start on **25 July 2022**, and we aim to have it complete by **Mid-September 2022**. We'll start on School Road near the Royal Oak pub and will progress up to the junction of The Crescent. To keep you and our work force safe, we've agreed with the local authority to use a **road closure** around our working areas. If you live within the road closure, our team will do their best to always maintain access for you and emergency vehicles.

Once the team have reached the junction of The Crescent, they'll be working under **multi-way traffic lights** to continue to keep everyone safe. Please see a plan overleaf showing where we'll be working.

Please bear with us

There may be times when our vehicles or equipment might be temporarily blocking access so, please bear with us during these times. We appreciate that it can be a pain to have this work happening near you - but please be assured that we (along with our contract partner Heartlands) will do everything we can to minimise any disruption. We'll do our very best to keep to the above dates, but they may change due to circumstances beyond our control.

Will my water supply be affected?

If we plan to interrupt your water supply, we'll notify you 48 hours in advance with a card stating the date and the earliest start and latest end time of the interruption. During or after the work, there's a small chance your water may appear discoloured. This is nothing to worry about and will quickly go back to normal.
