#### Year 6

## The Victorians - Friday 6th January 2023

Children are invited to travel back in time to 1896 by coming into school wearing suitable Victorian School dress for our Victorian School Day on the 29<sup>th</sup> April. The children will arrive in school dressed as Victorians and line up in two lines of boys and girls to begin their day. After handwashing and hand inspection, the children will experience what school life was like in the Victorian era by taking part in a range of activities. This will include a traditional arithmetic lesson, handwriting, British Values and Victorian Art in the afternoon. Children will also participate in Victorian playground games such as hopscotch, skipping and marbles.

#### Year 5

Year 5 will be taking part in the Viking worship as you know. We encourage children to dress up as a Viking or Anglo Saxon. They will learn about how Vikings lived, handling artefacts and will even taking part in a re-enactment Viking battle.



### Year 4

During our Inspiration Day, Year 4 will be visiting mountains of the world. We will be considering what a mountaineer needs to complete a dangerous mountain trek and during the afternoon, we will create some mountain-inspired artwork.
