House Points/Leaf Assembly

As many of you will be aware, last year we introduced 'platinum cards' to our behaviour system. If the children do not have a red or yellow card for the whole week, they get a 'platinum point'. When they have three platinum points, they receive a house point. This system ensures the children who behave well all the time are rewarded. The system ensures that no children miss out on the recognition they deserve for good behaviour.

The 'Gold Leaf' award has always been very sought after by the children. Many children challenge themselves throughout the year to try and achieve this award. The children who reach 'gold' will have behaved beautifully throughout the year, showed a positive attitude and also produced excellent work.

In order to ensure the gold award stays prestigious now that there are 12 potential house points awarded via platinum points, we have revised the amount of house points required in order to receive the bronze, silver and gold leaves.

Silver Leaf – 15 house points Gold Leaf – 25 house points

Bronze leaf will remain at 3 house points for this academic year as some children have already received the leaf with this threshold. Going forward, Bronze leaf will be awarded after 5 house points.

Book Quiz


















Well done to Noah and Millan in 5B for some amazing Diwali writing! I have only included as short extract from each but they boys completed the whole story to a very high standard!



worship next week!











